Next production *The Maids* by Jean Genet

directed by Neal Barber

Production dates May 4-13 (Note the dates, which are later than first advertised.)

As you will know, this production replaces Troilus and Cressida, which could not be cast. However, we think that you will find this a fascinating alternative (in every way). The following information has been provided by Neal for the flyers for this play:

"What is identity? *The Maids* explores the ways in which identity politics intersect with servitude, gender, self-representation, and criminality. The play is based on a real-life story of a pair of French maids who murdered their mistress; these two maids fantasise both about killing their mistress and the glamour of criminality.

Solange and Claire (the maids of the title) always play a role. Throughout the play, we hardly ever get to see who they really are. They begin by playing the roles of servant and mistress; they play the role of servitude for the mistress; and return to playing their fantasy roles. We see only brief glimpses of the people who play these different social roles. As the action unfolds, each gets more carried away with their parts and they seem to become swept away as pawns in the tempests of an other's actions.

To complicate matters, Genet was interested in the artificiality that is the soul of theatre. Even when we see the 'real' Claire, we only see an actor *pretending* to be Claire. Genet shows us not only how a servant plays the role that their master requires but also that everyone constantly plays a variety of such roles; we are all in a state of perpetual servitude to somebody or something.

Our production plays with the absurdist qualities of Genet's play. We utilise elements of ritual, masks, ennui and actor doubling. We hope to challenge you, entertain you, and, most of all, inspire you..."
