FUNDRAISING FOR "ROOF REPAIR"

Most of you will now that we need a little over \$500,000 to carry out the conservation repair of the theatre building that is needed so urgently. You will also know that we succeeded in raising half of this within 6 months, by the end of December 2014. **Much of the promised funding, however, is conditional on the whole sum being raised by October 2014** so we urgently need to raise more, much more. Since January 2014 we have raised: \$1,800 from individual donations and have been granted \$6,000 from trusts, \$1000 from the Edward Theomin Charitable Trust and \$5,000 from Southern Trust. We have lodged applications for grants totalling over \$150,000 from several other trusts. And are applying to many more. We are investigating crowd-funding sites and are also, as you will have seen, filling the Globe with many more productions than we would normally stage in order to raise as much as we can from box office returns.

Please help us raise the final half million by:

'Buying' a seat in the auditorium (\$50 silver, \$100 gold);

Becoming a 'theatre ghost' (\$1,000 gold, \$5,000 platinum) in a place of your choice in the theatre;

Donating funds via cheque (made out to The Friends of the Globe theatre), or directly into the Globe's 'project fund' account (03 0903 0451937 017)

(All donations over \$5 are eligible for tax credit.)
